

# We Will Tell Them!

Psalm 78

*My people, hear my teaching; listen to the words of my mouth. <sup>2</sup>I will open my mouth with a parable; I will utter hidden things, things from of old—<sup>3</sup>things we have heard and known, things our ancestors have told us. <sup>4</sup>We will not hide them from their descendants; we will tell the next generation the praiseworthy deeds of the LORD, his power, and the wonders he has done. <sup>5</sup>He decreed statutes for Jacob and established the law in Israel, which he commanded our ancestors to teach their children, <sup>6</sup>so the next generation would know them, even the children yet to be born, and they in turn would tell their children. <sup>7</sup>Then they would put their trust in God and would not forget his deeds but would keep his commands. <sup>8</sup>They would not be like their ancestors—a stubborn and rebellious generation, whose hearts were not loyal to God, whose spirits were not faithful to him. **Psalm 78:1-8***
