Main Idea: Trials are inevitable. Suffering is optional.

What is your this?

After this, Job lived a hundred and forty years; he saw his children and their children to the fourth generation. ¹⁷ And so Job died, an old man and full of years. **Job 42:16-17**

1. Be a Person of Praise

At this, Job got up and tore his robe and shaved his head. Then he fell to the ground in worship ²¹ and said: "Naked I came from my mother's womb, and naked I will depart. The Lord gave and the Lord has taken away; may the name of the Lord be praised."
²² In all this, Job did not sin by charging God with wrongdoing.
Job 1:20-22

2. Be a Person of The Precepts

"But he knows the way I take. When he has tested me I shall come forth as gold. ¹¹ My foot has held fast to his steps. I have kept his way and not turned aside; ¹² I have not departed from the commandments of his lips. I have treasured the words of his mouth more than my necessary food. **Job 23:10-12**

3. Be a Person of a Penitent Heart

¹ Then Job replied to the Lord :

⁴ "You said, 'Listen now, and I will speak; I will question you, and you shall answer me.' ⁵ My ears had heard of you but now my eyes have seen you. ⁶ Therefore I despise myself and repent in dust and ashes.
Job 42:1, 4-6

4. Be a Person of Perspective

¹ "Then Job answered the Lord and said, ' I know that you can do anything and no purpose of yours can be withheld from you...

¹ "Then Job replied to the LORD: ² 'I know that you can do all things; no purpose of yours can be thwarted. ³ You asked, 'Who is this that obscures my plans without knowledge?' Surely I spoke of things I did not understand, things too wonderful for me to know. ... ⁵ My ears had heard of you but now my eyes have seen you: ⁶ Therefore I despise myself and repent in dust and ashes." **Job 42:1-3, 5-6**

5. Be a Person of Prayer

After Job had prayed for his friends, the LORD restored his fortunes and gave him twice as much as he had before. **Job 42:10**
