1. *"Father, forgive them, for they know not what they are doing."* **Luke 23:34**

There is *forgiveness* from the cross.

2. *"I tell you the truth, today you will be with me in paradise."* **Luke 23:43**

There is *salvation* from the cross. And, it is found through faith in Him alone.

3. *"Dear woman, here is your son,"* and to the disciple, *"Here is your mother."* **John 19:26-27**

4. *"Eloi, Eloi, lama sabachthani?"* - which means, "My God, my God, why have you forsaken me." **Matthew 27:46;**

Mark 15:34

There is *atonement* from the cross.

5. *"I am thirsty."* **John 19:28**

There is *suffering* from the cross.

6. *"It is finished."* **John 19:30**

There is *obedience* to God from the cross.

7. *"Father, into your hands I commit my spirit."* **Luke 23:46**

There is *eternal security* because of the cross.
