This "power to change" is God's <u>sanctifying</u> work in the believer's life. It means to be set apart, consecrated, and made holy.

1 Thessalonians 4:1-12 - Living To Please God

<sup>3</sup>It is God's will that you should be sanctified: that you should avoid sexual immorality;...<sup>9</sup> Now about your love for one another...you yourselves have been taught by God to love each other....<sup>11</sup> and to make it your ambition to lead a quiet life: You should mind your own business and work with your hands...

**Main idea:** Sanctification is a <u>progressive work</u> of God and man making us <u>more</u> free from sin and like Christ in our actual lives. (Wayne Grudem, Systematic Theology). In other words, we can <u>change!</u>

3 Truths About God's Sanctifying Work In Us

1. Believe you can change to be more like Christ.

And we all...are being transformed into his image with ever-increasing glory, which comes from the Lord, who is the Spirit. **2 Cor. 3:18** 

2. Know that you and God cooperate in this transformation.

Your role: <u>Learn, yield, obey</u>

God's role: <u>Teach</u>, empower, change you

3. Celebrate the joy of living more like Christ.

But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, forbearance, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, <sup>23</sup>gentleness and self-control. **Gal. 5:22-23**
