Introduction

Proverbs 1:10-19 - Warning Against Enticement

My son, if sinful men entice you, do not give in to them. ¹¹ If they say, "Come along with us; let's lie in wait for innocent blood, let's ambush some harmless soul; ¹² let's swallow them alive, like the grave, and whole, like those who go down to the pit; ¹³ we will get all sorts of valuable things and fill our houses with plunder; ¹⁴ cast lots with us; we will all share the loot"—¹⁵ my son, do not go along with them, do not set foot on their paths; ¹⁶ for their feet rush into evil, they are swift to shed blood. ¹⁷ How useless to spread a net where every bird can see it! ¹⁸ These men lie in wait for their own blood; they ambush only themselves! ¹⁹ Such are the paths of all who go after ill-gotten gain; it takes away the life of those who get it.

Main Idea: When facing peer pressure, wisdom will follow <u>God's</u> <u>will</u> instead of <u>following along</u>.

4 Ways To Follow God's Will Instead of Following Along

1. Choose your friends wisely.

The righteous choose their friends carefully, but the way of the wicked leads them astray. **Prov. 12:26**

Walk with the wise and become wise, for a companion of fools suffers harm. **Prov. 13:20**

2. Expect enticements along your life journey.

...if sinful men entice you...if the say "Come along with us..." Prov. 1:10-11

3. Take the warnings very seriously.

...lie in wait for their own blood...they ambush only themselves...it takes away the life of those who get it. **Prov. 1:18-19**

4. Have the courage and conviction to <u>walk away</u> even when it's hard.

...if sinful men entice you, do not give in to them...do not go along with them...do not set foot on their paths. **Prov. 1:10, 15**
