## Introduction

## Proverbs 6:6-11 - Learn From The Ant

Go to the ant, you sluggard; consider its ways and be wise! <sup>7</sup> It has no commander, no overseer or ruler, <sup>8</sup> yet it stores its provisions in summer and gathers its food at harvest. <sup>9</sup> How long will you lie there, you sluggard? When will you get up from your sleep? <sup>10</sup> A little sleep, a little slumber, a little folding of the hands to rest— <sup>11</sup> and poverty will come on you like a thief and scarcity like an armed man.

Proverbs 10:4 - Lazy Hands Verses Diligent Hands

Lazy hands make for poverty, but diligent hands bring wealth.

**Proverbs 14:23 - Hard Work Verses Mere Talk**All hard work brings a profit, but mere talk leads only to poverty.

Main Idea: When you are tempted to be lazy, choose to be a <u>diligent worker</u> because diligent work brings a profit but lazy hands lead to poverty.

## 4 Truths To Help You Become A Diligent Worker

1. Get up and get going instead of lying in bed.

Do not love sleep or you will grow poor; stay awake and you will have food to spare. **Prov. 20:13** 

As a door turns on its hinges, so a sluggard turns on his bed.

Prov. 26:14 (See also Prov. 6:9-11, 10:5)

2. Understand work is about <u>solving problems</u> and <u>bringing value</u> to others.

I went past the field of a sluggard, past the vineyard of someone who has no sense; <sup>31</sup> thorns had come up everywhere, the ground was covered with weeds, and the stone wall was in ruins. **Prov. 24:30-31** 

3. <u>Stay focused</u> on doing the work instead of mere talk or distractions.

All hard work brings a profit, but mere talk leads only to poverty.

Prov. 14:23 (See also 12:11)

4. <u>Grow your skills</u> to grow your opportunities, impact and influence.

Do you see someone skilled in their work? They will serve before kings... **Prov. 22:29**
