Plans fail for lack of counsel, but with many advisers they succeed.

Proverbs 15:2

Whoever corrects a mocker invites insults; whoever rebukes the wicked incurs abuse. ⁸ Do not rebuke mockers or they will hate you; rebuke the wise and they will love you. ⁹ Instruct the wise and they will be wiser still; teach the righteous and they will add to their learning. **Proverbs 9:7-9**

Whoever heeds life-giving correction will be at home among the wise.

Main Idea: Wise people <u>listen</u>. They listen to and appreciate advice and correction because they know it helps make them wiser.

4 Truths To Help You Listen To Advice And Correction To Become A Wiser Person

1. Be <u>secure</u> in your identity while also being humble and wise enough to know you have some blind spots.

2. <u>Seek out</u> wise counsel and correction and <u>thank</u> them for being honest with you.

3. Prayerfully develop <u>a plan</u> to work on the areas that need improvement and <u>implement</u> the plan.

4. Proactively get <u>continuous feedback</u> until the needed behaviors become your normal behaviors.
