Introduction

John 19:28-30 - It Is Finished

Later, knowing that everything had now been finished, and so that Scripture would be fulfilled, Jesus said, "I am thirsty." ²⁹ A jar of wine vinegar was there, so they soaked a sponge in it, put the sponge on a stalk of the hyssop plant, and lifted it to Jesus' lips. ³⁰ When he had received the drink, Jesus said, "It is finished." With that, he bowed his head and gave up his spirit.

4 Accomplishments Of Christ's Finished Work

- 1. <u>Redemption</u>: Purchased our freedom from sin and guilt (Mark 10:45, Romans 3:24, Colossians 2:13-14)
- 2. Propitiation: Satisfaction of God's wrath (Hebrews 2:17, Romans 3:15)
- **3.** <u>Reconciliation</u>: Restoration of mankind from a separated relationship with God (Romans 5:10, 2 Corinthians 5:18-19)
- **4.** <u>Defeat of Darkness</u>: Satan and the powers of darkness have been defeated (Hebrews 2:14, Colossians 3:15)

Main Idea: The finished work of Jesus' death on the cross made It possible for you to have a relationship with God.

3 Ways To Apply The Finished Work of Christ To Your Life

1. Realize you have a <u>sin debt</u> before our Holy God and its <u>consequences</u>.

2. Realize you can be forgiven and reconciled to God by the finished work of Christ by <u>repenting</u> and becoming a <u>follower</u> of Jesus.

3. Realize all of the <u>benefits</u> of the finished work of Christ and becoming a follower of Jesus.
