## II. Because <u>God Is Holy</u>

### Introduction

Later, knowing that everything had now been finished, and so that Scripture would be fulfilled, Jesus said, "I am thirsty." <sup>29</sup> A jar of wine vinegar was there, so they soaked a sponge in it, put the sponge on a stalk of the hyssop plant, and lifted it to Jesus' lips. <sup>30</sup> When he had received the drink, Jesus said, "It is finished." With that, he bowed his head and gave up his spirit. John 19:28-30

Main Idea: Because there was <u>no other way</u> for us to have a <u>relationship</u> with him.

# I. Because <u>God Loved Us</u> And Wanted A <u>Relationship</u> with Us

For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life. John 3:16

But God demonstrates his own love for us in this: While we were still sinners, Christ died for us. Romans 5:8

I am the LORD your God; consecrate yourselves and be holy, because I am holy. Do not make yourselves unclean by any creature that moves along the ground. <sup>45</sup> I am the LORD, who brought you up out of Egypt to be your God; therefore be holy, because I am holy. **Leviticus 11:44-45** 

### III. Because We Are Not As Good As We Think
