1. The way you use your time reflects your priorities.

Lord, you have been our dwelling-place throughout all generations. **Psalm 90:1**

2. Your time on earth is brief.

Consider the number 25,550.

Our days may come to seventy years, or eighty, if our strength endures; yet the best of them are but trouble and sorrow, for they quickly pass, and we fly away. **Psalm 90:10**

Teach us to number our days, that we may gain a heart of wisdom. **Psalm 90:12**

3. Your time on earth is <u>uncertain</u>.

Relent, Lord! How long will it be? Have compassion on your servants. Satisfy us in the morning with your unfailing love, that we may sing for joy and be glad all our days. **Psalm 90:13-14**

4. Your time on earth may endure.

May the favor of the Lord our God rest on us; establish the work of our hands for us – yes, establish the work of our hands. **Psalm 90:17**
