**Main idea:** God is holy and His holiness should affect us!

**4 Ways God's Holiness Should Affect Us**

**Isaiah 6:1-8**

Isaiah's Commission

*In the year that King Uzziah died, I saw the Lord, high and exalted, seated on a throne; and the train of his robe filled the temple. <sup>2</sup> Above him were seraphim, each with six wings: With two wings they covered their faces, with two they covered their feet, and with two they were flying.*

<sup>3</sup> *And they were calling to one another:*

*"Holy, holy, holy is the LORD Almighty; the whole earth is full of his glory."*

<sup>4</sup> *At the sound of their voices the doorposts and thresholds shook and the temple was filled with smoke.*

<sup>5</sup> *"Woe to me!" I cried. "I am ruined! For I am a man of unclean lips, and I live among a people of unclean lips, and my eyes have seen the King, the LORD Almighty."*

<sup>6</sup> *Then one of the seraphim flew to me with a live coal in his hand, which he had taken with tongs from the altar. <sup>7</sup> With it he touched my mouth and said, "See, this has touched your lips; your guilt is taken away and your sin atoned for."*

<sup>8</sup> *Then I heard the voice of the Lord saying, "Whom shall I send? And who will go for us?"*

*And I said, "Here am I. Send me!"*

- 1. The first way God's holiness should affect us is just understanding its meaning. God's holiness means perfection.** (Cf. Psalm 18:30)
- 2. The second way God's holiness should affect us is that it magnifies our sin.** (Isaiah 6:5)
- 3. The third way God's holiness should affect us is that it requires atonement.** (Isaiah 6:6-7)
- 4. The fourth way God's holiness affects us is that it should motivate action.** (Isaiah 6:8)
  - a) You should be motivated to take the time to correctly know your God.** (See e.g., Jeremiah 9:23-24)
  - b) You should be motivated to be more holy.** (Cf. 1 Peter 1:16, Leviticus 11:45)
