Introduction

Psalm 119:1-3 - Living A Blessed Life

Blessed are those whose ways are blameless, who <u>walk</u> according to the law of the LORD. ² **Blessed** are those who <u>keep</u> his statutes and seek him with all their heart—³ they do no wrong but <u>follow</u> his ways.

See how much the Psalmist loves and delights in God's Word in verses 14, 16, 47-48, 72, 111, 127-128, 129, 140.

Main Idea: The blessed person <u>delights in and lives according to</u> God's Word.

4 Ways You Are Blessed By Delighting In And Living According To God's Word

1. It helps keep you from sinning.

I have hidden your word in my heart that I might not sin against you. (Vs. 11)

How can a young person stay on the path of purity? By living according to your word. (Vs. 9)

2. It gives you wisdom and guidance.

Your statutes are my delight; they are my counselors. (Vs. 24)

Your word is a lamp for my feet, a light on my path. (Vs. 105)

Your commands are always with me and make me wiser than my enemies. ⁹⁹ I have more insight than all my teachers, for I meditate on your statutes. ¹⁰⁰ I have more understanding than the elders, for I obey your precepts. **(Vs. 98-100)**

3. It strengthens and comforts you when you are weary.

My soul is weary with sorrow; strengthen me according to your word. (Vs. 28)

My comfort in my suffering is this: Your promise preserves my life. **(Vs. 50)**

Great peace have those who love your law, and nothing can make them stumble. (Vs. 165)

4. It equips you to live in freedom.

I will walk about in freedom, for I have sought out your precepts. (Vs. 45)
