## **Introduction**

### **1 Timothy 6:11-16 - Man of God**

*But you, **man of God**, **flee** from all this, and **pursue** righteousness, godliness, faith, love, endurance and gentleness. <sup>12</sup> **Fight** the good fight of the faith. Take hold of the eternal life to which you were called when you made your good confession in the presence of many witnesses. <sup>13</sup> In the sight of God, who gives life to everything, and of Christ Jesus, who while testifying before Pontius Pilate made the good confession, I charge you <sup>14</sup> to keep this command without spot or blame until the appearing of our Lord Jesus Christ, <sup>15</sup> which God will bring about in his own time—God, the blessed and only Ruler, the King of kings and Lord of lords, <sup>16</sup> who alone is immortal and who lives in unapproachable light, whom no one has seen or can see. To him be honor and might forever. Amen.*

**Main idea: Being a man of God is measured by what you flee from, follow after and fight for.**

1. Flee from the love of money. (See verses 6-10)
2. Follow after godly virtues. (Verse 11)
3. Fight the good fight of faith. (Verse 12)
