Introduction

Matthew 6:19-34 - Storing Up Treasures In Heaven

- ¹⁹ "Do not store up for yourselves treasures on earth, where moths and vermin destroy, and where thieves break in and steal. ²⁰ But store up for yourselves treasures in heaven, where moths and vermin do not destroy, and where thieves do not break in and steal. ²¹ For where your treasure is, there your heart will be also.
- ²² "The eye is the lamp of the body. If your eyes are healthy, your whole body will be full of light. ²³ But if your eyes are unhealthy, your whole body will be full of darkness. If then the light within you is darkness, how great is that darkness!
- ²⁴ "No one can serve two masters. Either you will hate the one and love the other, or you will be devoted to the one and despise the other. You cannot serve both God and money.
- ²⁵ "Therefore I tell you, do not worry about your life, what you will eat or drink; or about your body, what you will wear. Is not life more than food, and the body more than clothes?
- ³³ But seek first his kingdom and his righteousness, and all these things will be given to you as well.

Main idea: Storing up treasures in Heaven requires keeping God first in everything!

4 Ways To Keep God First In Everything

1. Begin by choosing God as your master.

2. Learn to seek first His will and righteousness everyday.

3. Choose to <u>invest</u> in God's kingdom and <u>your heart</u> will align there as well.
